

Use Google Meet in Google Classroom to sign in virtually to our learning in class

1. Sign into Google classroom as you normally would
 - By signing in directly on a Google webpage
 - By clicking the quick sign in on our newsletter
 - By clicking the quick sign in on our website

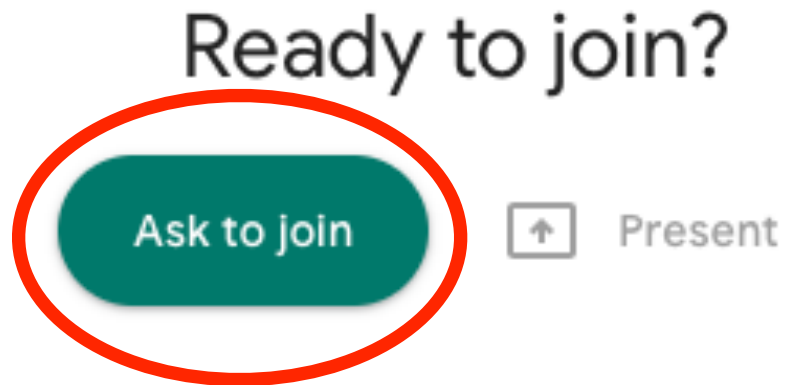

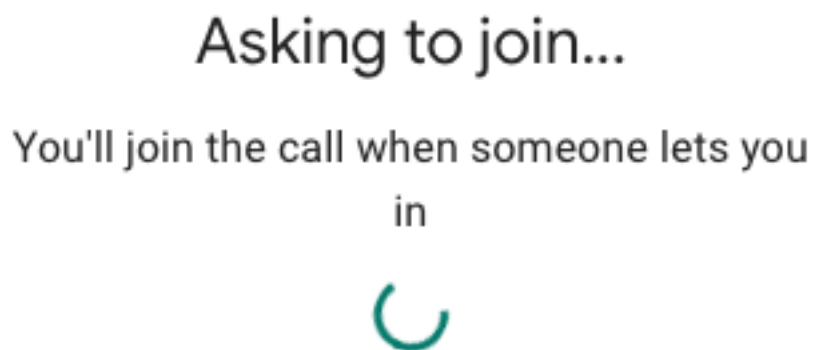
2. From the Classroom home page (Stream), you will see a Google Meet Link.

3. Allow Google Meet to use your microphone and camera
4. Press 'Ask to Join'

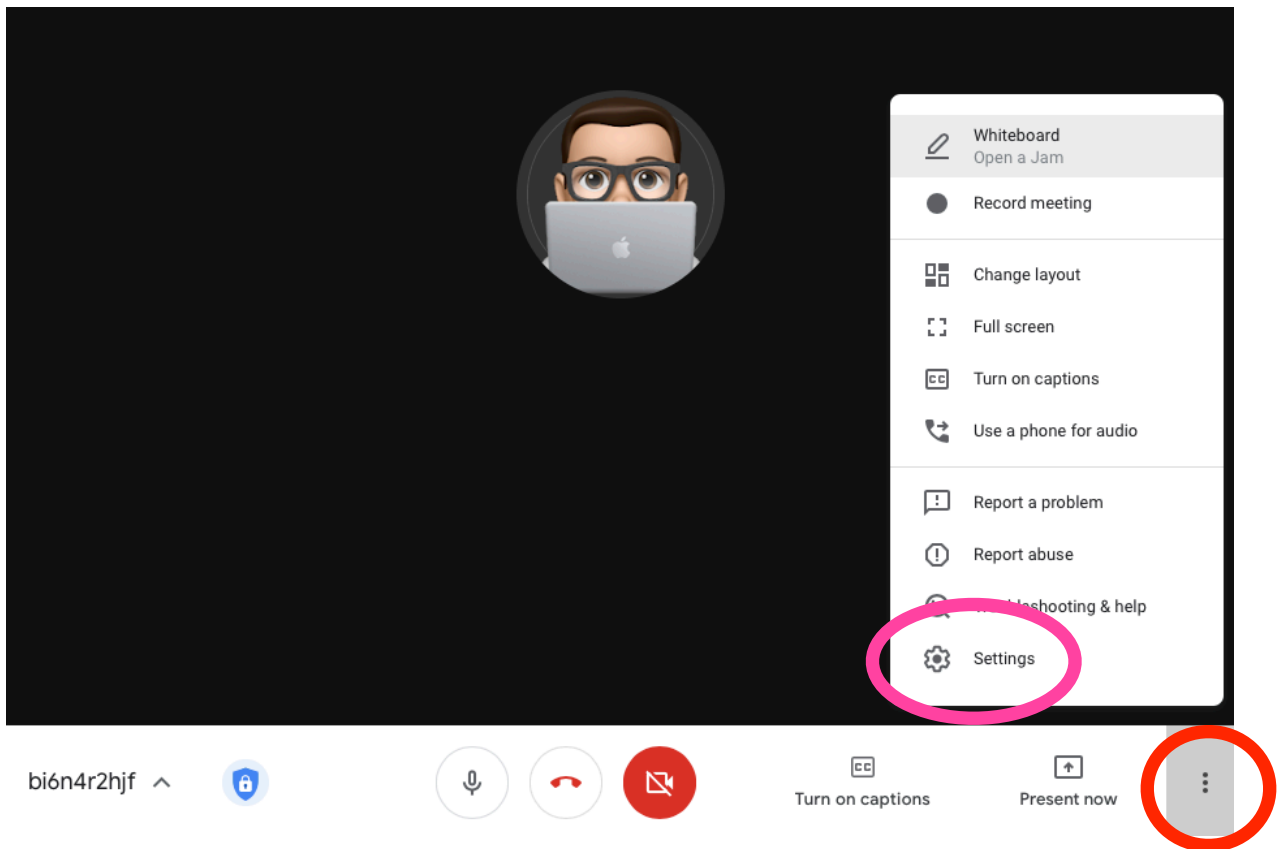


5. You will get this message until a teacher lets you in to the virtual classroom.



6. Once your teacher lets you into the classroom, your screen will automatically change to the virtual classroom. You should then be able to hear and see your teacher and your classroom.

7. You need to check the quality of your video. To do this click the **three vertical dots** in the bottom right hand corner and click **settings**.



8. The default quality is 'Standard Definition 360p'. You need to change this to 'High Definition 720p'. This needs to be on both Send resolution and Receive resolution.
